Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q: What is on the USB Flash Drive?

A: The USB Flash Drive includes the full concert video file with sound incorporated (mp4) and mastered audio files (wav and mp3). Videos are viewable on computers and TVs with a USB port. You can also download these files from the USB to your computer and then to your phone (via Airdrop, for example). Note: the full concert files are large files (10+ GB).

Q: Do I need special software to play the recordings?

A: No special software is required. The video and audio files are standard formats (mp4, wav, and mp3) and will play on any computer with QuickTime or other media players installed. On TVs, they are viewable once the TV's input is set to the USB input.

Q: How are DVDs and CDs different from the USB?

A: DVDs offer the full concert video playable on standard DVD players. CDs include only the mastered audio, playable on CD players. USB is a versatile option, playable across multiple devices. USB includes all files that can be saved, backed up, or downloaded to other devices.

Q: Why does delivery take 4–6 weeks?

A: During the event, we'll be recording with multiple professional microphones and video cameras. Each camera's footage then moves into post-production editing, and each microphone's audio into post-production mixing and mastering, at The Recording Center. Angles are selected, edited, audio gets mixed and treated. A lot happens in this stage. Professional post-production takes time, care, and consideration, and once complete, I then spend time on duplication, printing, and packaging of your DVDs, CDs, and USBs. Pre-orders and online orders are then all shipped together!

Q: Can I make or share my own recording of the concert?

A: No. *Personal recording or publishing of this MHSA licensed concert is not allowed.* The official recordings produced here are the only authorized versions.
